- ☐ Verify High School Graduation Requirement Met
- ☐ Meet with Academic Advisor (October/November)
- ☐ Verify Program of Study Declared
- ☐ Register for Fall 2022 Classes – early April
- ☐ Attend Campus Orientation - Recommended
- ☐ Pick up your diploma from high school – 3rd week of May
- ☐ **Send Final HS Transcript to college** – mid-May via Parchment.com

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- ☐ Apply to College as high school graduate of 2021
- ☐ Complete FAFSA: www.fafsa.gov
- ☐ Meet with Admissions at Selected College
- ☐ Retake SAT for scholarships (check Merit Scholarships)
- ☐ Complete Scholarship Applications:
- ☐ Verify High School Graduation Requirement Met
- ☐ LCC: Contact StarZone to complete MTA-Core Audit Form, 2nd Floor Gannon Bldg or 517-483-1957 (January)
- ☐ Request college transcript sent to transfer college (after May 15th)
- ☐ Attend an Orientation
- ☐ Pick up diploma from high school – 3rd week May
- ☐ **Send Final HS Transcript to College** – mid-May via Parchment.com

October

Complete the FAFSA – Financial Avenue for questions
Apply to colleges – **Graduation Year 2022 – First time High School Graduate**
Review all high school AP and CTE courses for possible college credit or consider CLEP
Visit the college of your choice and meet with an academic advisor
Verify you completed the MTA – refer to checklist
Make any schedule changes for spring that may be required – Due November 1st

November

Begin Scholarship applications

January

LCC Student: Apply for MTA Audit after Spring registration – Gannon Building Star Zone @ LCC main campus
Apply for scholarships

March

Review financial packages and determine how much additional funding is required

April

Meet with Academic Advisor to register for Fall 2022
Register for Fall 2022 if remaining with LCC

May

Complete college acceptance steps – register for orientation
Pick up your high school diploma (3rd week May) – after your final college grades are recorded
Send final transcript to college (after May 15th)
Send final high school transcript to college (mid-May via Parchment.com)
